

From "Nishi Ogikubo" station, about 20 minutes on foot.

The station building has only two Exits. (North and South) After leaving the gate of station, take the left one (North Exit: where the bus stops are) and enter the street left of "Sumitomo Mitsui Bank (三井住友銀行)" at the corner. Follow this road straight ahead to a bridge which leads you over "Zempukuji-gawa river (善福寺川)". Cross the bridge, turn sharp right into the small path which follows the river downstream 200 meters, until you come to a small park called "Sekine Bunka Koen(関根文化公園)" which has a pool enclosed by a stark fence. Walk through the park (about only 20m wide). By leaving it turn right and follow the street another 10m until you come to a red brick wall. Turn left into the narrow street there and walk straight ahead. Although it looks a little bit like a dead-end you will be surprised to find out that you are not going to hit your head into a garage door within a rather tall wall but that you can actually "climb" a small hill on the left. On top turn left again into a narrow flower bed path. From there on just follow you nose...

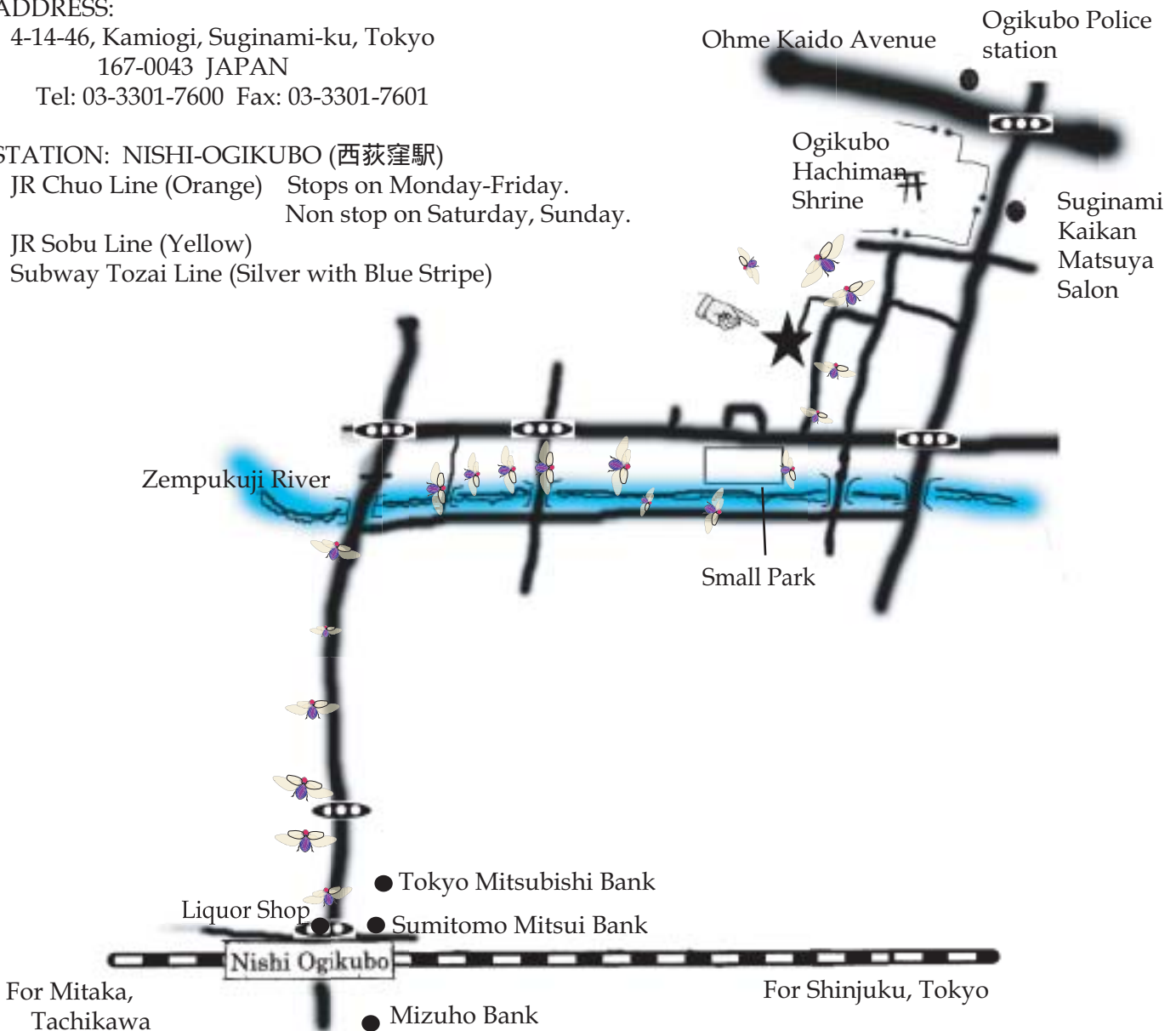
STATION: NISHI-OGIKUBO (西荻窪駅)
